

Managing reporting windows

Reporting windows are an optional function that can be used to manage when judgments are made for groups of students. PaCT administrators can set up reporting windows for the school which PaCT will use to send notifications to teachers, reminding them when to make judgments.

To set up and manage reporting windows:

1. Go to the Manage tab.
2. Select Reporting windows.

On the Reporting windows section of the Manage tab you can:

3. View your list of reporting windows.
4. Search and filter your list of reporting windows.
5. Edit the details of existing reporting windows.
6. Check which groups and students are not included in a reporting window. Expanding this section shows you:
 - a. Active groups in the school that are not included in a reporting window.
 - b. Students in the school that are not in an active group (e.g. not in a reporting window).
7. Hide any reporting windows that have been completed or are no longer needed by:
 - a. Selecting the reporting window(s) to be hidden.
 - b. Clicking the 'Hide' button.
This will deactivate the reporting window and all its functions on move it into the 'Hidden reporting widows' list.
 - c. Hidden reporting windows can be reactivated from the hidden reporting windows tab by clicking the Activate button.

Reporting windows in PaCT are optional. You can use them to help manage when your teachers will enter judgments for their students and in which frameworks. Reporting windows can be set up from 1 to 26 weeks long and have any combination of frameworks and groups included. They will also appear in the filter options for reporting. If you no longer want to use a reporting window (i.e. from previous years), you can hide them.

To create a reporting window:

8. Select Create new reporting window.
9. Enter the reporting window name (it is recommended that you use unique and concise names).
10. Select the start and end date (these must be no more than 26 weeks apart).
11. Select one or more frameworks.
12. Select the groups you would like to include.
13. Add these groups to the reporting window by clicking the arrows.
14. Add any additional teachers required (select from dropdown).
15. Note the reminders and notifications that will be sent.
16. Select Save reporting window.

Reminder/Notice	Detail
One week before start date	Teachers need to start their judgments in one week. Reminds them to prepare.
On start date	Teachers can now start making judgments.
Five days before the reporting window ends	Teachers now have only five days remaining to confirm and submit their judgments for this window.
